- 7a. Participants:** A maximum of four players per event from: Bermuda TTA, Table Tennis Canada, United States Table Tennis, US Virgin Islands TTA.
- 7b. Eligibility:** All participants must meet ITTF eligibility rules for Olympic events.

- 8. Format of play:**
- Event 1:* Will be played by single elimination.
Seeding will be based on the last available World Ranking.
The draw will be made according to ITTF rules, without separation by association.
MEN: The winner of the event is the first continental qualifier.
WOMEN: The winner is the second continental qualifier.
- Event 2:* Will be played by single elimination.
All players non-qualified through Event 1 will be eligible to participate in Event 2.
- The higher ranked (WR) semi-finalist will be seeded 2 and will go to the position 8.
 - The remaining semi-finalist and the highest ranked (WR) quarter-finalist will be seeds 3-4 and will be drawn into the positions 4-5
 - The three remaining players will be drawn into the positions 3, 6 and 7 without separation by Association.
- Qualification:**
- MEN: The winner of Event 2 is the second continental qualifier.
WOMEN: The winner is the third continental qualifier - provided her association has not yet qualified two players. Should the winner's association already have two qualified women, the winner is the first continental reserve.

Event 3: Will be played by single elimination.
 All non-qualified players (and non-event winners) from Events 1 and 2 will be eligible to participate in Event 3.

- The runner-up in Event 2 will be seeded 1 and will go to position 1, getting a bye in the first round
- The higher ranked (WR) semi-finalist will be seeded 2 and will go to the position 8, getting a bye in the first round
- The remaining semi-finalist and the highest ranked player (WR) among the quarter-finalists will be seeds 3-4 and will be drawn in to the positions 4-5. • The two remaining players will be drawn into the positions 3 and 6 without separation by Association.

MEN: The winner of Event 3 is the third continental qualifier, provided that his association has not yet qualified two players. The next highest finishers - in order of finish - are either the third continental qualifier (if he has not yet been established) or, the continental reserves; a continental reserve can only come from an NOC which has not exhausted the Olympic entry restriction of 2 players per NOC.

WOMEN: If Event 2 has established the first continental reserve, the highest finisher of Event 3 - provided that her association has not yet filled the "2 per NOC" entry restriction - will be the third continental qualifier. The finishing order will determine any additional reserves in order of finish (if needed)

The ITTF Olympic Qualification system governs the qualification system outlined above.

 The finalist of Day 1 will be the #1 seed on Day 2.
 The finalist of Day 2 will be the #1 seed on Day 3.
