

***2018 Canadian Junior Open
Frequently Asked Questions***

- 1. How many Canadian Teams are allowed to compete (Junior, Cadet, Boys and Girls)?**

12 players per category (see [prospectus](#) ; the ITTF Competition Manager will decide the number of teams once he knows the overall entry; 2 per category or he may allow more.

- 2. How many Canadian players are allowed to enter single event (Junior, Cadet, Boys and Girls)?**

12 players per category (see [prospectus](#))

- 3. Who are qualified in Team A, Team B or Team C (Junior, Cadet, Boys and Girls)?**

Once we have the entries, the coaches will make Team A and B; if there are remaining spots, more teams can be made.

- 4. Will TTCAN pay some portion of the whole cost if he/she got selected?**

Top two in each category get a contribution according to the National Team Selection Policy

- 5. Should TTCAN do the entry for the player if he/she confirmed to compete?**

Yes, only TTCAN can enter players in the event. Entries need to be sent to Iris Ma.

- 6. Should a player arrive on May 27 and depart on June 1st?**

Yes; except for Ivy Liao; the North American Hopes Challenge is the 31st, 1st, 2nd - players have been invited.

Depending on the overall entries some Hopes players may be able to play in the Cadets.

- 7. Who are the coaches for all Canadian players or he/she is allowed to have own coach?**

Peter-Paul, Liu, Wang, Surprenant are the coaches for Team A and B;

Others can have their own coaches.
